

JOB DESCRIPTION: Classroom assistant

- To assist within a classroom team providing behaviourally based instruction to children with autism and related communication disorders
- To provide personal care (e.g. toileting, nappy changing and feeding) for children within the school
- To supervise snack and lunch and indoor/outdoor playtime for all children
- To understand and actively implement all school policies
- To participate in relevant staff meetings and training
- During the period of employment, to undertake appropriate professional development on a range of relevant issues as agreed by the school management
- To work as part of a team
- To ensure confidentiality at all times
- To undertake other duties as appropriate

*Qualified to NVQ Level 3 or equivalent

*Have experience of working for children.
